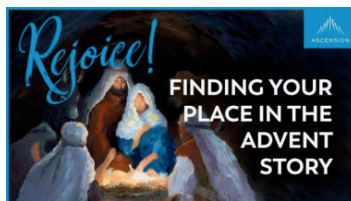
## ADVENT BEGINS!
