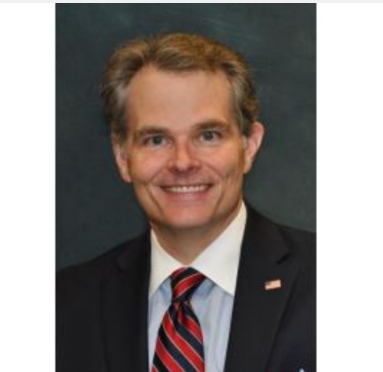
KAREN JENKINS

An important focus, if accepted to the Parish Board, would be to identify community outreach strategies to attract youth, young adults and young families to the parish, providing them vibrant opportunities to grow in their faith.
